All entrants must:

- Beware of traffic, marshals, spectators, the general public and other entrants abide by the orders and directions of marshals, race organisers and police observe
  and obey all signs along the route
- Abide by the Highway code in the road sections of the course and to show respect and consideration to all users of the highway and other users of the footpaths and bridleways and give way to other users
- Read and abide by the race instructions (see final instructions, you can find this on the webpage)
- Ensure they are medically fit to enter the race
- Be aged 18 or over
- Enter with an expectation of completing within the time limits set out in the Race Pack in respect of cur off times and understand that there will be no
- support, sweep vehicle or provision of emergency services outside the time limit
- NOT bring dogs or other pets on the course
- NOT wear ipods or other musical devices, as the road sections will not be closed
- There maybe some coloured powder paint so please be aware of this and if is a problem for you then an alternative route will be offered to bypass this
- Be prepared for all weather and conditions and be self reliant
  - Be aware the course will run in the dark with no external lighting save for your own head torches and therefore acknowledge:
    - 1. You will bring a head torch with sufficient power to enable you to run with no ambient light off road
    - 2. You are an experienced enough runner to be able to run at night off road through mud and water if necessary

• PLEASE NOTE THAT THERE WILL BE STROBE LIGHTING AT TIMES and if this is an issue for you then we will offer a full refund (subject to reasonable requirement to evidence medical issue if necessary) please contact us regarding this as soon as possible

## Right to Refuse Entry

The Narberth Nobbler Organising Committee reserve the right to refuse entry to any persons not complying with the terms and conditions and reserve the right to make any last minute changes to the event, other than those previously publicised, for reasons of safety.

Data Protection
